

Woodland Park Board of Education Board Member Vacancy

The Woodland Park Board of Education has a vacancy on the Board of Education to be filled by a resident of the Woodland Park Borough. The appointed term shall be from date of appointment through December 31, 2022.

Those eligible residents of the Woodland Park Borough having an interest in filling the position shall send a letter providing information about themselves and summarizing their interest in the position. All letters must be received by 4:00 pm on Tuesday, May 24, 2022.

Interviews will be held by the Board of Education at our regularly scheduled public board meeting during public session on Monday, June 13, 2022. Meeting start time is 7:00pm.

Legal requirements:

To become a member of a local board of education in New Jersey, you must—

- Be able to read and write
- Hold U.S. citizenship and one year's residency in the school district
- Be registered to vote in the district before filing the nominating petition
- Have no interest in any contract with, or claim against, the board
- Not hold office as mayor or member of the municipal governing body or, in the case of county school districts, the county governing body
- Not simultaneously hold two elective offices
- Not be disqualified from membership for the conviction of certain crimes. (Within 30 days of election or appointment to the board, a member must undergo a criminal history background investigation through the state Department of Education.)
