Will the money be taken from someplace else or will the position be eliminated. She also asked about the dress code policy that was being revised. She wanted to know if it was for students or staff and what the revision was.

Dr. Pillari said \$31,500 had to be used at BG since they are a targeted school. State aid would supplement the rest so that the supervisor can be utilized in all 3 schools. The policy was for staff wearing blue jeans on designated days. The change was that Principals would provide the Superintendent with a list of these days for approval.
