Karen Criscione - Co-President WPEA

Mrs. Criscione had questions about resolutions 218-168 & 218-169. On 218-169 she asked if application was submitted for funds. She stated that available funds from this can be used for afterschool help for students, as well as coaching and PD for staff. Mrs. Criscione expressed concern regarding 218-169. She asked what this consultant can bring to the table. She wanted to know what background and prior experience she has in elementary education. She also asked if this person is the best fit for the staff & students, since she is not a specialist in ELA or Math and have we done due diligence, funding the money in the right manor. Mrs. Criscione wanted to know what approach the plan would be taking. She said through data analysis, we can find specific areas where help is needed. She stated one model does not fit everyone; that different subgroups have different needs. She also said that BG staff has asked about having afterschool academic help, like Memorial has.

Mrs. Marshall stated that resolution 218-169 was being pulled from the agenda. She said that she thought the academic support at BG was a good idea. She stated that since only two teachers signed up at Memorial, she thought that there wasn't any interest.

Mrs. Criscione added that since this was offered mid-year, most teachers have made other commitments; other tutoring jobs, taking classes, etc. She suggested that if they continue this next year to let it be known at the beginning of the school year.

Mrs. Carbonelli stated that the teachers at BG have approached her about the afterschool extra help and are interested in implementing it.
