We will have a change in report card format this year. The committee discussed the possibility of a 9<sup>th</sup> period for the arts. They were discussing outsourcing a theater production company to assist in middle school plays; shared services with PV was a suggestion.

**Finance:** Mrs. Mitchell stated that if the parent of an 8<sup>th</sup> grader had a balance in their child's lunch account they can get reimbursed or have the money transferred to a younger siblings account by calling the business office. Also, if paying with cash, change will be given out if the child asks for it.
