217-171-FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT CONTRACT RENEWAL – POMPTONIAN INC.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Woodland Park Board of Education, the FSMC shall receive, in addition to the costs of operation, an administrative/management fee of \$.1688 per reimbursable meal and meal equivalent to compensate the FSMC for administrative and management costs. This fee shall be billed monthly as a cost of operation. The SFA guarantees the payment of such costs and fee to the FSMC.

Total meals are calculated by adding reimbursable meal pattern meals (breakfast and lunch) served and meal equivalents. The number of reimbursable meals served to the children shall be determined by actual count. Cash receipts, other than sales from of reimbursable program meals served to the children, shall be divided by \$3.50 to arrive at an equivalent meal count.

The per meal administrative/management fee of \$.1688 will be multiplied by total meals. The FSMC guarantees the SFA a no cost of operation for the SFA for school year 2017-2018.
