Janet Russo – 13 Lincoln Lane

Mrs. Russo had the following concerns regarding the opening of School #1:

Why is the \$495,000 budgeted into the 16-17 budget, when it won't be used until the 17-18 budget?

Mr. DiFluri responded that this was clarified with the NJ Dept. of Education. Taxes will be collected in January and May of 2017, and held, to be used in the 2017-2018 school year.

Where will the money come from when it's time to add/renovate bathrooms?

Capital reserve money has/will be set aside for these improvements.

Will there be increased costs for transportation, crossing guards, insurance, etc.

There will be no increase in transportation. Crossing guards, insurance, etc., costs have been incorporated in the \$495,000.

Increase in administration costs.

The district is subject to restrictions from the State on administration. It's calculated by the number of students, not the number of buildings.

Will all environmental testing be done on the building before proceeding with opening?

Yes, all testing has/will be completed.

Other options?

The Board has looked into placing a soundproof divider in the Memorial School cafeteria at a cost of approximately 60-80 thousand dollars, but only alleviates part of the problem. Trailers are not an option at Memorial because it is a flood zone. The cost of adding on to Charles Olbon far exceeds the costs of re-opening School #1.

Francie Joseph – 149 Jackson Ave.

Ms. Joseph spoke, as a past board member, on behalf of utilizing the property we already own. She said unless you received enough money selling it to cover costs adding on to another school, it makes the best sense to maximize what we already have.
