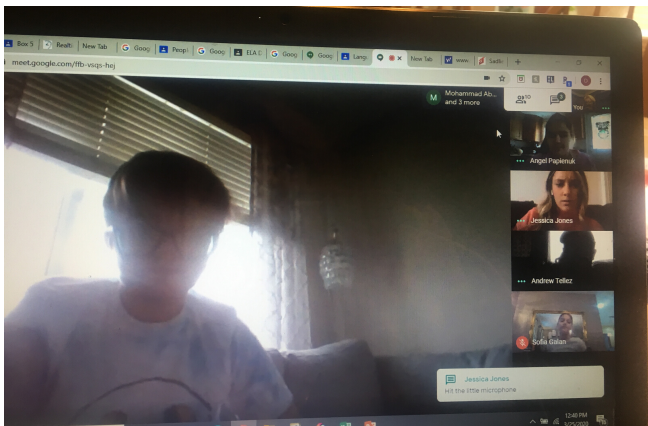
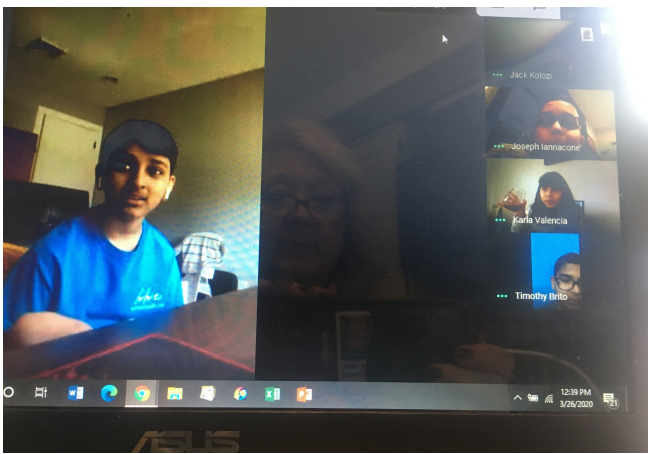

Charles Olbon and Beatrice Gilmore School students and staff members have been having special spirit days at home.



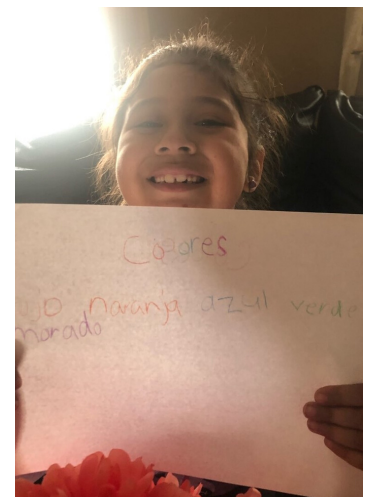
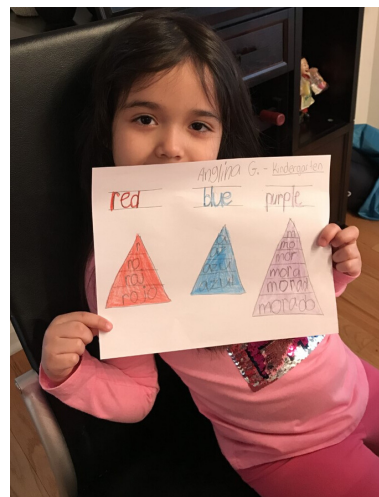
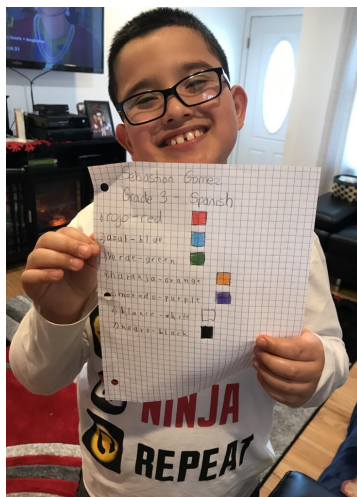
## Sharing His Story

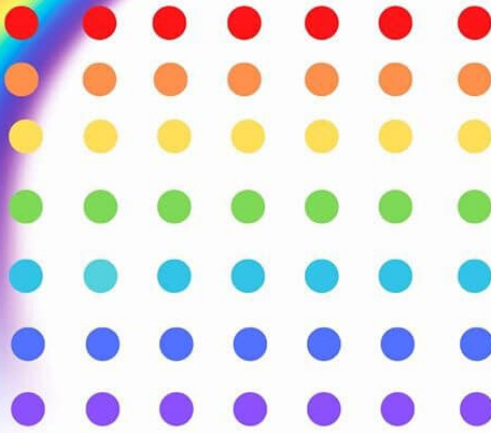

### Who Qualifies for Full Day Preschool?

Any child who is a resident of Woodland Park and who will be 3 or 4 years of age by October 1, 2020.

### How many seats are available?

There are 52 - 3-year-old seats and 42 - 4-year-old seats available for September 2020 to be filled by a lottery drawing.
