

Read Aloud


Ms. Healey's first graders have been enjoying her Read Aloud videos during their at-home learning.

Who Qualifies for Full Day Preschool?

Any child who is a resident of Woodland Park and who will be 3 or 4 years of age by October 1, 2020.

How many seats are available?

There are 52 - 3-year-old seats and 42 - 4-year-old seats available for September 2020 to be filled by a lottery drawing.
