A Peek At What We Are Learning

October all Preschoolers continued their Study Investigations!

The in person Preschool classes have started their investigations about Trees (3yr olds) and they are learning why trees are important, who lives in trees and what comes from trees! Simple Machines (4 yr olds). They are learning about levers and pulleys and where we find them in our environment and what we do with them.

The virtual Preschool classes are beginning their investigations (3 yr olds) about Balls and (4 yr old) Signs. They are learning to compare and contrast with different size balls. The 4 yr old class is learning about the importance of signs and where we find them in our life.

They are all learning some new vocabulary words like circumference, harmful vs. helpful and directional words (up, over, under, through). They learned rhyming through the use of nursery rhymes.
