**When your child has completed an activity, please initial and date the activity box on the Choice Boards.** Below are the required minimum number of assignments to be completed for each subject area:

- ELA: 1 activity per day
- Math: 1 activity per day
- Science: 3 activities per week
- Social Studies: 3 activities per week
- Music: 1 activity per week
- Art: 1 activity per week
- World Language: 1 activity per week
- Physical Education: 1-2 activities per week
- Health: 1 activity per week

Students who participate in BSI, ESL, Wilson Reading, and/or who have an IEP, will have supplemental activities and modifications included in their packets.
